A nest containing three fresh eggs, found on May 14, 1916, forms our only record of this species. Progne subis subis. Purple Martin. Common over the entire county, nesting in the many boxes erected for them, in the eaves of buildings in San Antonio, and in abandoned woodpecker holes in telephone poles along some of the railroad tracks. Nests in May and June. Petrochelidon lunifrons lunifrons. Cliff Swallow. This species is found in small colonies in many portions of the hill area, where the overhanging...
